There is a regional body which oversees the game in Yorkshire. It has a regional calendar which is a mixture of club events and regional events. It also helps administer local leagues and selects players to represent Yorkshire in competitions and has qualified coaches and umpires to help clubs develop. Individuals can join Yorkshire Pétanque. Individuals can also join Pétanque England - the national governing body. This costs £33 a year. £25 goes to PE & £8 to YP.
