Can I play Pétanque in Greenhead Park?

- 1. Any individual or group can use the terrain at any time when the park is open for social play when it is not reserved for a HPC session. It's a public park. You'll need your own boules.
- 2. The clubhouse is closed outside club sessions.
- 3. Current club sessions are Sunday, Tuesday & Thursday 1300 to 1700. There are some days when a longer session operates and some extra days. See our playing calendar.
- 4. Groups who want to have a closed session for their members where they borrow boules, receive coaching/umpiring from club members and have a competition organised for them will have to buy a day membership at a rate of £3-50 per person for a day or part of a day. This will include access to clubhouse facilities.
- 5. A deposit of £20 will secure any group booking. The balance is payable on the day.
- 6. If the event cannot proceed due to inclement weather the deposit will be retained and an alternative date agreed.
- 7. There are no toilet facilities in the clubhouse.
- 8. Public toilets are available near the café and also in the pub.
- 9. The terrain can hold up to 60 players playing in pairs on 15 lanes.

Typical Pétanque day/afternoon/evening session

- Arrival, housekeeping, introduction to the game -10 minutes
- o Rules explained and practice on terrain with club members 30 minutes
- Types of shot, advice on tactics, game management 30 minutes
- Coffee break 20 minutes
- 2 or 3 round competition with club members umpiring between 1 & 2 hours
- Photo opportunity, Debrief, Presentation of prizes and close
- Can be modified to suit your requirements but a minimum of 3 hours is recommended.
